The goal of Random Act of Kindness Week is to change schools, the workplace, families, and society through kindness

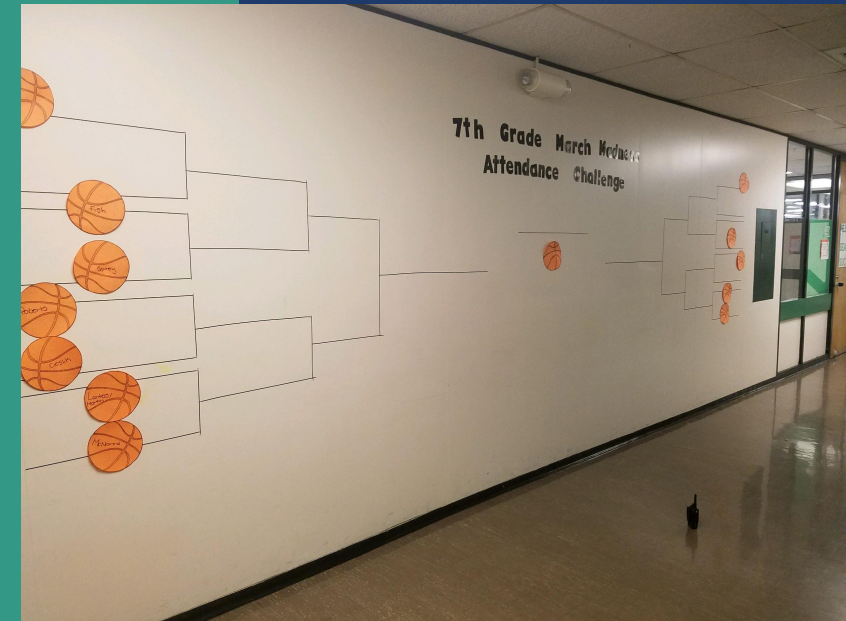
